Dear Parents and Carers,

Children who stay for enrichment can now choose any of the clubs we offer for their age group. Places are limited and booked strictly on a first come first served basis and payment is via **Parent Pay** as normal.

Any children who do not join enrichment <u>must</u> be collected at **2.00pm** at the end of the official school day. None of the clubs that run on a Wednesday afternoon are bookable on a week by week basis. If you choose to take your child home at the end of the school day (2.00pm) then this arrangement will need to stay in place for the whole term.

Enrichment ends at 3.10pm on Wednesday and children must be collected at this time.

Those children who are walking home on their own will need written consent in their planners to this fact. We will be unable to send home children on a Wednesday afternoon at 2.00pm or 3:10pm without this written consent.

Late Collection

Late collection of children at either 2:00pm if not attending an enrichment club or 3:10pm if attending an enrichment club will incur the normal after school club late fee if not picked up on time.

Booking and Payment

Activities are only bookable through Parent Pay which operates on a strictly first come first served basis. All activities must be paid in full at the time of booking. *Only if you do not* have the facility to use Parent Pay payment will be accepted in the form of cheque or cash.

If you do not have internet access we will make available a terminal in our reception for you to book your activities.

Cancellations

If a child is absent from a paid activity then the session will still need to be paid for. If an activity is cancelled by the school/supplier a credit will be issued against future bookings.

Any activities that do not reach their minimum running numbers may need to be cancelled or merged with another activity.

Important Notice

The school officially closes at 2.00pm on the Wednesday and teaching staff attend training sessions at this time and are not available. The reception will be closed from 2.30pm and there is no access into the school after this time, unless you are collecting children from 4 O'clock or Ziggy club. This is to ensure the safety of the children at all times.
